

NYC Department of Education – Chancellor’s Regulations: passed 6/2009 and implemented in high schools 9/2009.

Pertinent to the Opt-Out form:

1/ Distribute multilingual forms to all students and their parents by early October allowing them to withhold contact information from military recruiters. New students must receive the opt-out form in their orientation packets. Opt-out information also will be added to the Bill of Student Rights. Students will only have to opt-out once during their school careers, as opposed to at the beginning of each new school year.

2/ Designate a staff ‘point person’ on issues regarding military recruitment and notify students who it is.

3/ Develop procedures in each school for regulation military recruiter’s access, ensuring that students understand their op-out rights and receive opt-out forms.
